APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must provide:

- Completed application form
- Official academic transcripts
- One-page essay (500-600 words) to explain why you wish to participate in the Adolescent Diploma Course
- Two letters of recommendation
- Curriculum Vitae
- Lodging and meal selections

The course language is English. The applicant is assumed to have the necessary skills to pursue graduate level work in English. Among these are note-taking during oral lectures and the ability to write in an essay format.

An AMI Diploma 12-18 is granted upon satisfactory completion of the program requirements which include 90% attendance at lectures, residential experience and satisfactory completion of writing requirements, observations, literature review and implementation of study and work.

Required written work also includes:

- Daily journal with writing prompts related to the concepts explained that day/week (It can be good to bring a special book for this)
- Three essays, synthesizing and citing theory lectures, seminar discussion, and reading materials
- Lexicon of vocabulary terms related to Montessori theory and practice – researched with primary references to Montessori's work
- Plan of study and work
- Prospectus/overview of Vision, Philosophy, Methodology, and Components (based on Montessori's Plan of Study and Work)

Residential Experience on the farm

All participants need to spend at least three weeks on the farm during summer 2027, experiencing the daily life of the adolescents. The weeks required to stay at the farm are included in the tuition fee (**except for dinners and weekend meals**). Please see below.

PART 1

1st session: November 2nd – November 13th, 2026.

2nd session: June 28th - July 23rd, 2027. During this time, it is mandatory to stay at least the first three weeks on the farm in order to experience the residential life.

PART 3

Part 3 will take place between April 18th - May 26th, 2028, and includes the written and oral examinations.

HOUSING & MEALS

All sessions will be held at The Montessori Centre for Work and Study. The closest airport is Landvetter Airport (GOT), which is 15 minutes away by car. Participants are responsible for their own transportation.

Part 1 – session 1: Participants are welcome to stay on the farm for these two weeks. If the participant chooses not to stay on the farm, they are responsible for finding their own accommodation. Meals are the responsibility of the participant.

Part 1 – session 2: During the mandatory residential experience, participants need to spend at least the first three weeks on the farm, experiencing the daily life of the adolescents. The accommodation and meals (breakfast, lunch and snack Mon-Fri) will be provided and are included in the tuition fee. As for the fourth week, there is the option to continue staying on the farm or finding your own accommodation. Participants will cook dinners and weekend meals, and the cost will be shared amongst themselves.

Part 2: In between the onsite modules participants are required to conduct observations, practicum and written assignments.

Part 3: Participants are welcome to stay on the farm for these six weeks. If the participant chooses not to stay on the farm, they are responsible for finding their own accommodation. Meals are the responsibility of the participant.

Living at The Montessori Centre for Work and Study entails sharing rooms, kitchen and bathroom areas.

Room and board fees are based on participants' selections. There are two options: Please mark your option regarding accommodation.

- **Option 1:** Housing at the Montessori Farm Rydet for all weeks of the training (except the three weeks mandatory residential life included in the tuition fee):

SEK 250 per night (9 weeks = SEK 15 750):

- Part 1, session 1: 15 nights.
 - Part 1, session 2: 8 nights.
 - Part 3: 40 nights.
1. Meals: Breakfast, lunches and dinners are not included in the cost. These are the responsibilities of the participant
 2. Linen: Towels and sheets are provided (if you have the possibility to bring this yourself, this will be appreciated)
 3. Room: The participants share rooms and wardrobe space. The school house, farm house, and the nature outdoors provide areas for study. Washing machine is available.
 4. Housekeeping: Participants are responsible for cleaning their own living areas.
 5. Wireless internet and a printer will be available at the school house. You are welcome to bring your own printer as there are notes and assignments you are expected to print.
- **Option 2:** Find alternate housing on your own (except the three weeks mandatory residential life included in the tuition fee).

Mandatory meal plan (fourth week during summer 2027) = SEK 500.

1. This includes lunches and snacks provided Monday, July 19th – Friday, July 23rd, 2027.
2. All boarding and transportation costs are the responsibility of the participant.
