The AMI 12-18 Orientation is a 4-day course (25 hours) providing foundational Montessori theory and methodology for understanding the work with adolescents (12-18 years). Lecture topics focus on describing the developmental needs of the adolescent and the components of an adolescent community, including the prepared environment, the role of the adult, and the plan of study and work.

The course provides a vision of a Montessori adolescent community and is ideal for parents, administrators, visiting specialists/experts, and professionals from all areas of care involving adolescents. It is also an introduction for those considering the AMI 12-18 Diploma Course. Participants will have received information regarding the key elements of an engaging adolescent environment.

After participation in the on-site course, participants will be asked to complete a 2-hour observation of adolescents and a short written assignment.

Participants will receive an AMI certification upon completion of the orientation including assignments.
